National Cancer Patient Experience Survey 2025

The National Cancer Patient Experience Survey is run by NHS England and delivered by Picker, a health and social care research charity.

The survey is to help them understand and improve cancer and tumour care in England. They need help from those who have used NHS cancer services to test the survey and materials.

If you are interested Picker will schedule a convenient time for you to speak with a researcher to go through the questionnaire and materials with you to gather your feedback. The interview will be conducted over the telephone, or via video call with the opportunity to complete it in person. Your preferred method will be asked.

You can take part if you are aged 16 or above and have received cancer care in the last year at an NHS hospital.
